This is important. Please don't wait. Include this situation in your regular prayers now. The Bible tells us that God hears and responds. It tells us persistence matters. Let's do what the Bible shows us will work!

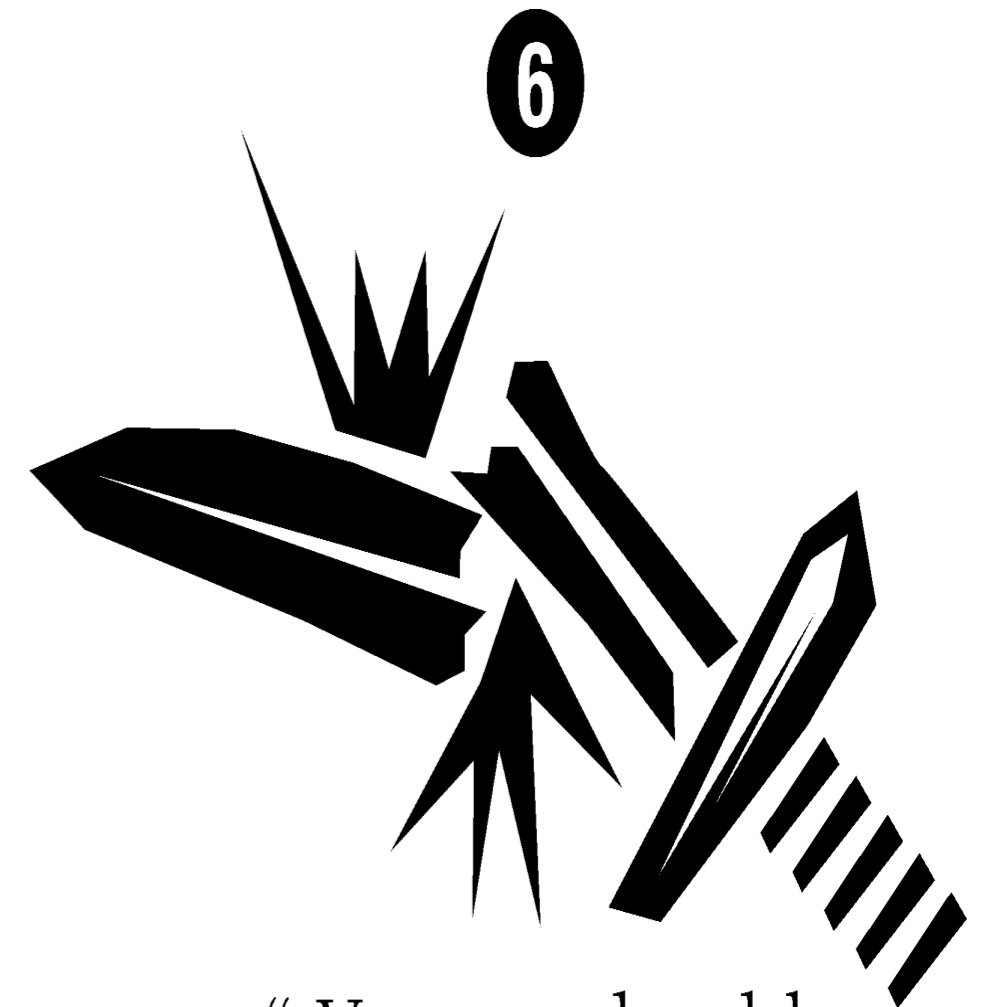
